

**EXPECTATIONS OF MEMBERS
FOR CONTINUED MEMBERSHIP IN THE INTERDISCIPLINARY
COLLABORATIVE PRACTICE GROUP FOR FAMILIES**

1. Members should strive to attend all monthly meetings.
2. If a member will miss a meeting, as a courtesy, the member should email the group to advise that he/she will not be attending.
3. Members must maintain their membership in the CLI-TX and the IACP.
4. Members must notify Interdisciplinary Group of public reprimand, suspension*, disbarment*, or inactive status of professional license.*
5. Members must promptly pay dues or other assessments within thirty (30) days of receiving notice. Failure to pay dues and other assessments will result in termination of membership.
6. Members should strive to attend annually CLE on collaborative law, mediation, or interest-based negotiation.
7. Members should strive to maintain at least three (3) collaborative cases per year.
8. Members must timely complete and submit annual reporting forms required by the Interdisciplinary Group.
9. Members may be removed from membership by vote of fifty-one percent (51%) of all members.
